Billings County, located in the midst of the Badlands is comprised of 1,152 square miles with approximately 52% of the lands owned by the State and Federal Government. The main industries are ranching/agriculture, tourism, and oil & gas. The population is approximately 1,000 people. Billings County has many attractions and the County Seat of Medora is considered North Dakota's number one tourist attraction.

The Recorder's office has completed indexing documents that have been exported to the NDRIN site **from 1940 – approximately March, to present**. Billings County is constantly working on this project with the ultimate goal of having all documents indexed on the NDRIN site. Please check with the Recorder's office for any updates on our indexing date.

Please note ALL Billings County documents have been imaged and exported to the NDRIN site, however those that are not indexed will require knowing a book and page number or document number (Book and page sequences were used until approximately October 2004 and document numbers were used after that date, starting with 122053).
